



OEHHA Announces Data Call-In for BPA

On January 18, 2008, the Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) announced its selection of five chemicals, including bisphenol A (BPA), for review by the Developmental and Reproductive Toxicant Identification Committee (DARTIC) for possible listing under Proposition 65. OEHHA is initiating the development of hazard identification materials for BPA and announced a 60-day data call-in for information relevant to the assessment of the evidence of the developmental and reproductive toxicity of BPA. OEHHA states that it will review and consider information received during the data call-in period as it prepares the hazard identification materials. OEHHA will announce the availability of the hazard identification materials, and the time, date, location, and agenda of the DARTIC meeting where BPA would be considered, in a subsequent notice. OEHHA anticipates that the hazard identification materials for BPA will be available for a 60-day comment period prior to the DARTIC meeting at which BPA will be considered.
