



NAMPA Expresses Disappointment over Introductory Resolution 1017 Passed By Suffolk County, NY Legislature

The North American Metal Packaging Alliance (NAMPA) is disappointed the Legislature of the County of Suffolk, New York, has approved an introductory resolution that challenges the scientific integrity of the U.S. Food and Drug Administration, and scientific regulatory bodies in the European Union, Canada, and Japan. Introductory Resolution 1017, as approved, could have far reaching and unintended consequences for the residents of Suffolk County. NAMPA is hopeful that the Legislature and County Executive will be receptive to additional information and comment from public health authorities, hospitals, and other experts who have reviewed the scientific aspects of this issue before final action is taken.
